As a team member on a major contract for the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), GCL investigated Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) sites, National Priority List (NPL) areas, sites at which there was a release or threat of release of hazardous materials, and sites that might have presented an imminent or substantial danger to the environment. Work under this contract included RCRA compliance support, responsible party searches, enforcement support services, health/environmental assessments, design of enforcement studies; enforcement feasibility studies, review of responsible party plans, field work, and oversight of responsible party actions. Additionally, GCL supported the EPA in the preparation of policy and technical assistance programs related to the implementation of the RCRA enforcement program.

GCL performed a number of assignments under this contract for EPA regions throughout the United States. Projects included endangerment assessments, closure plan, remedial investigation document review and QA/QC data verification, RCRA Facility Assessment, preliminary assessments and visual site inspections, underground storage tank audits, remedial design/remedial action oversight, and hydrogeologic technical support.
